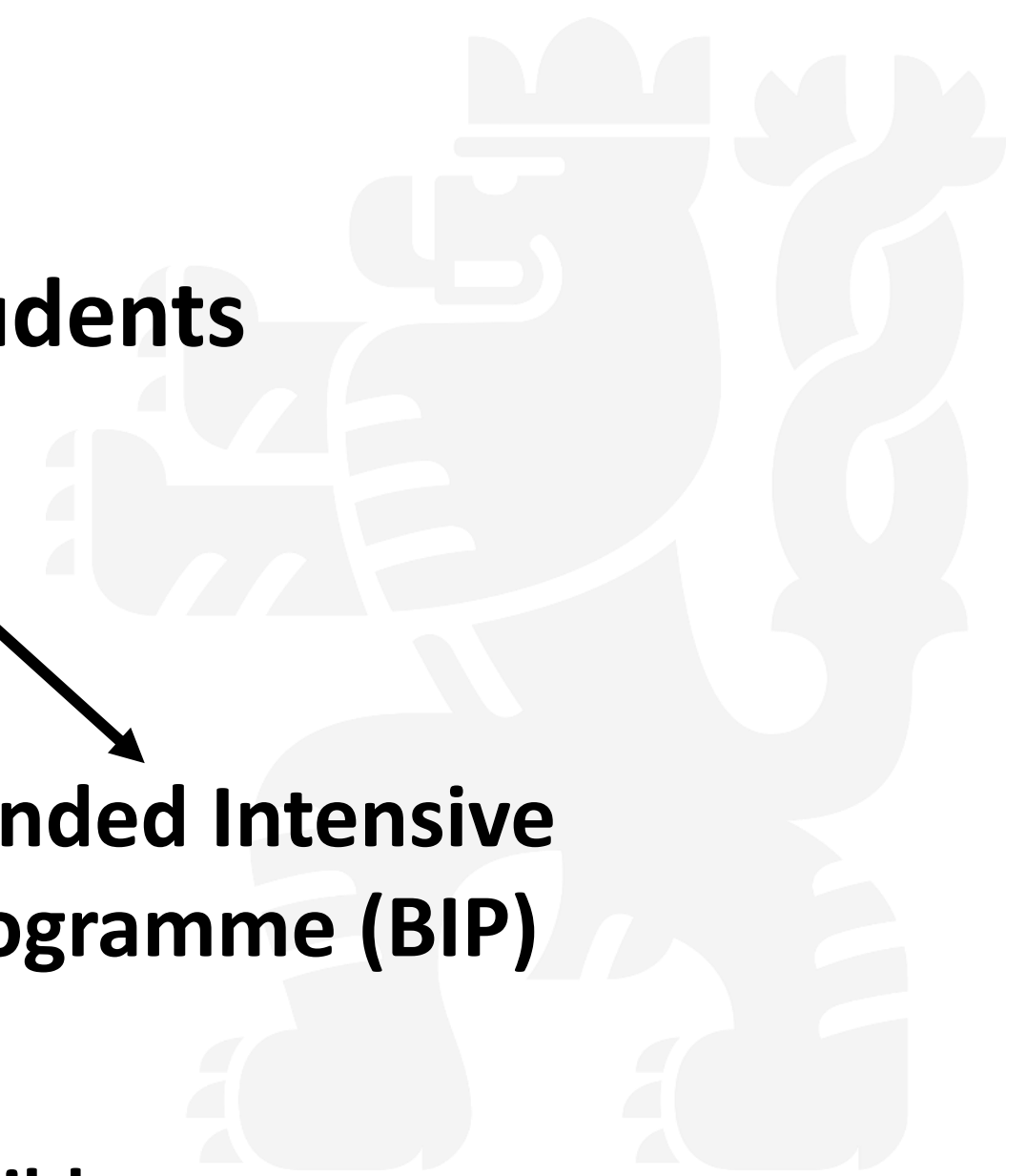

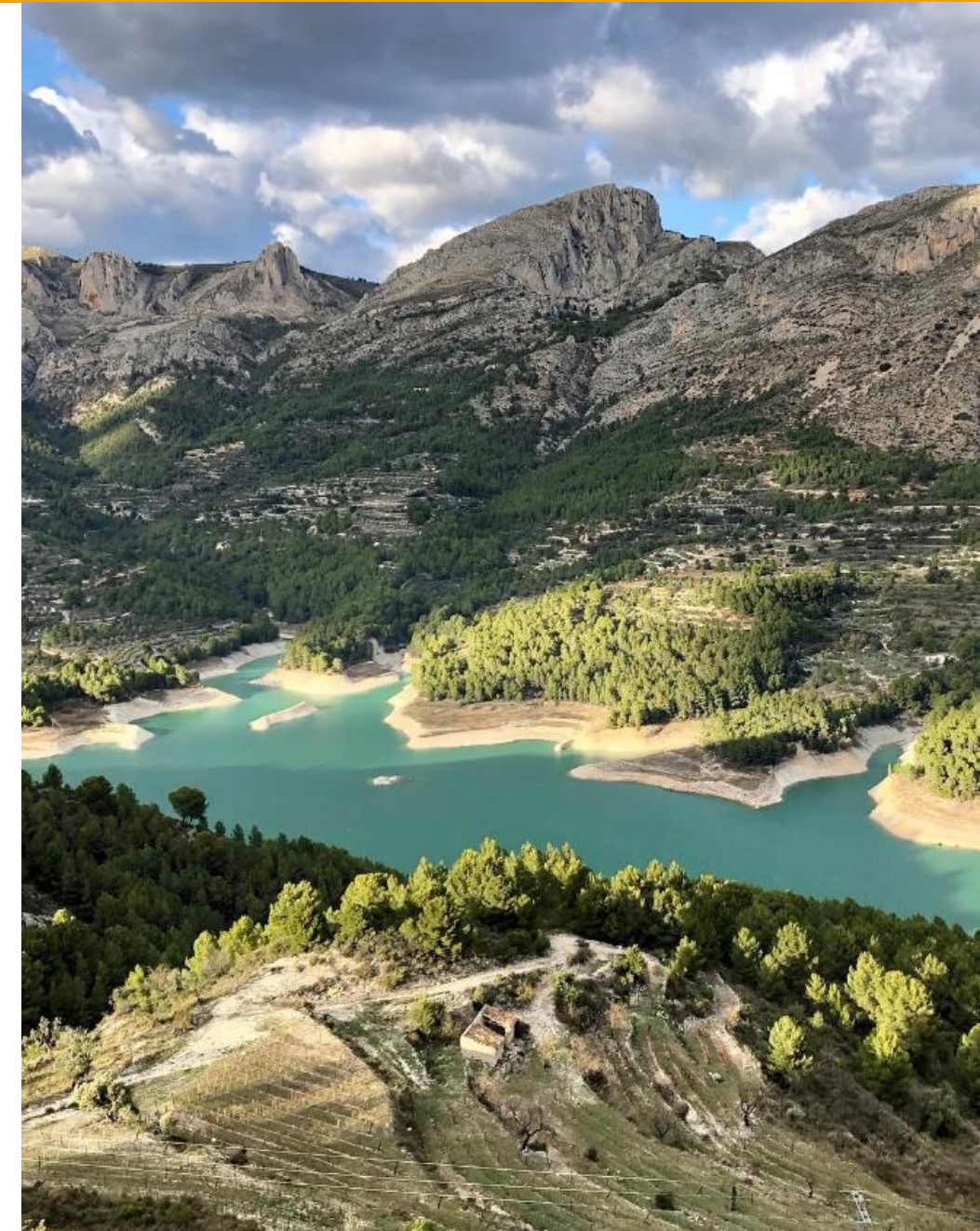
For how long?

Combination of study mobility + traineeship + BIP

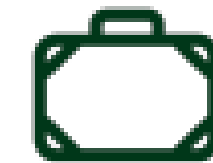

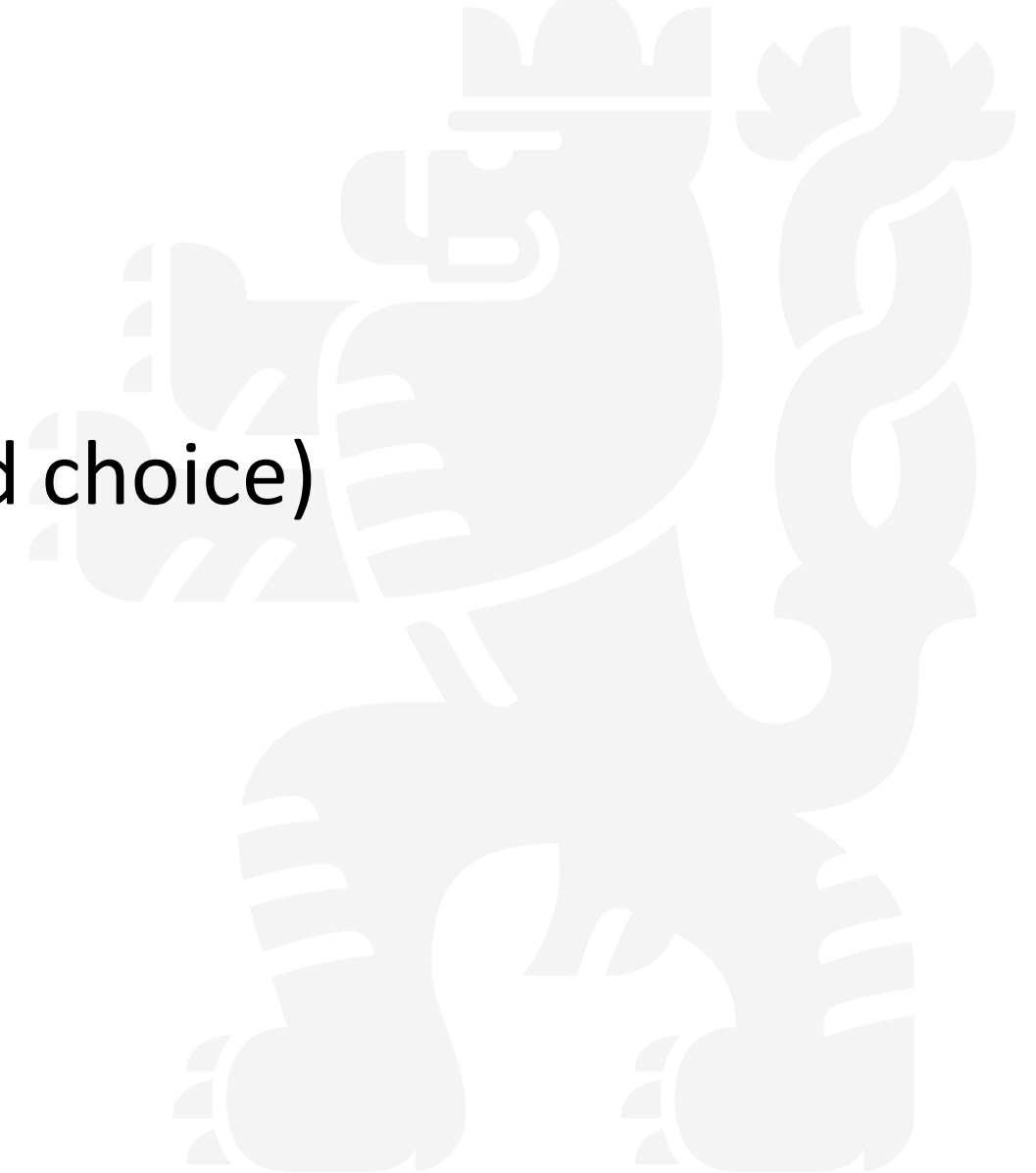
How to apply?



Selection procedure

Selection procedure takes place twice a year. Please contact the IRO office for current information.

- Required documents
 1. CV with contact details
 2. Motivation letter with a choice of univeristy (1st to 3rd choice)
 3. Transcript of Records from UIS
 4. Language certificate (optional)

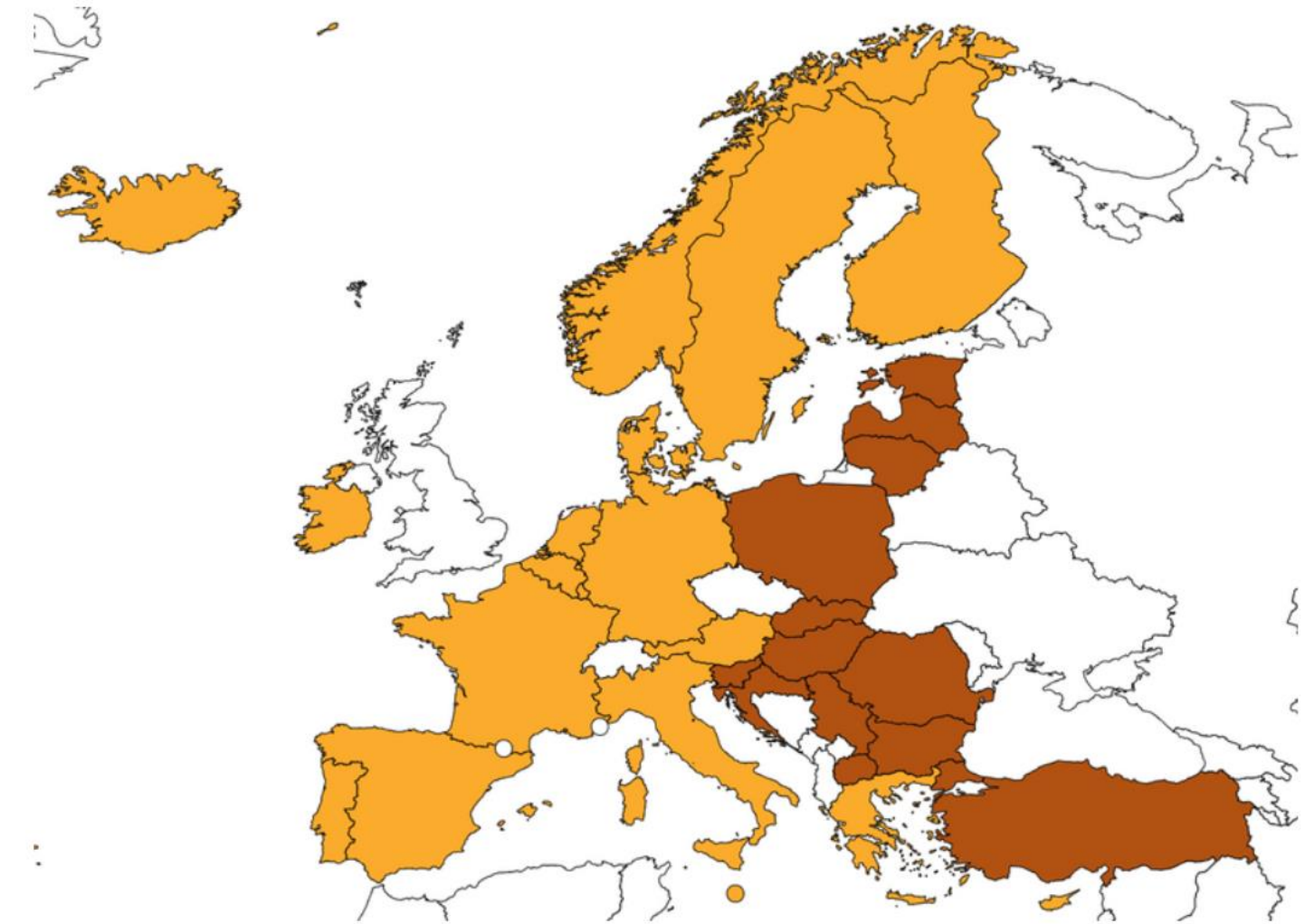

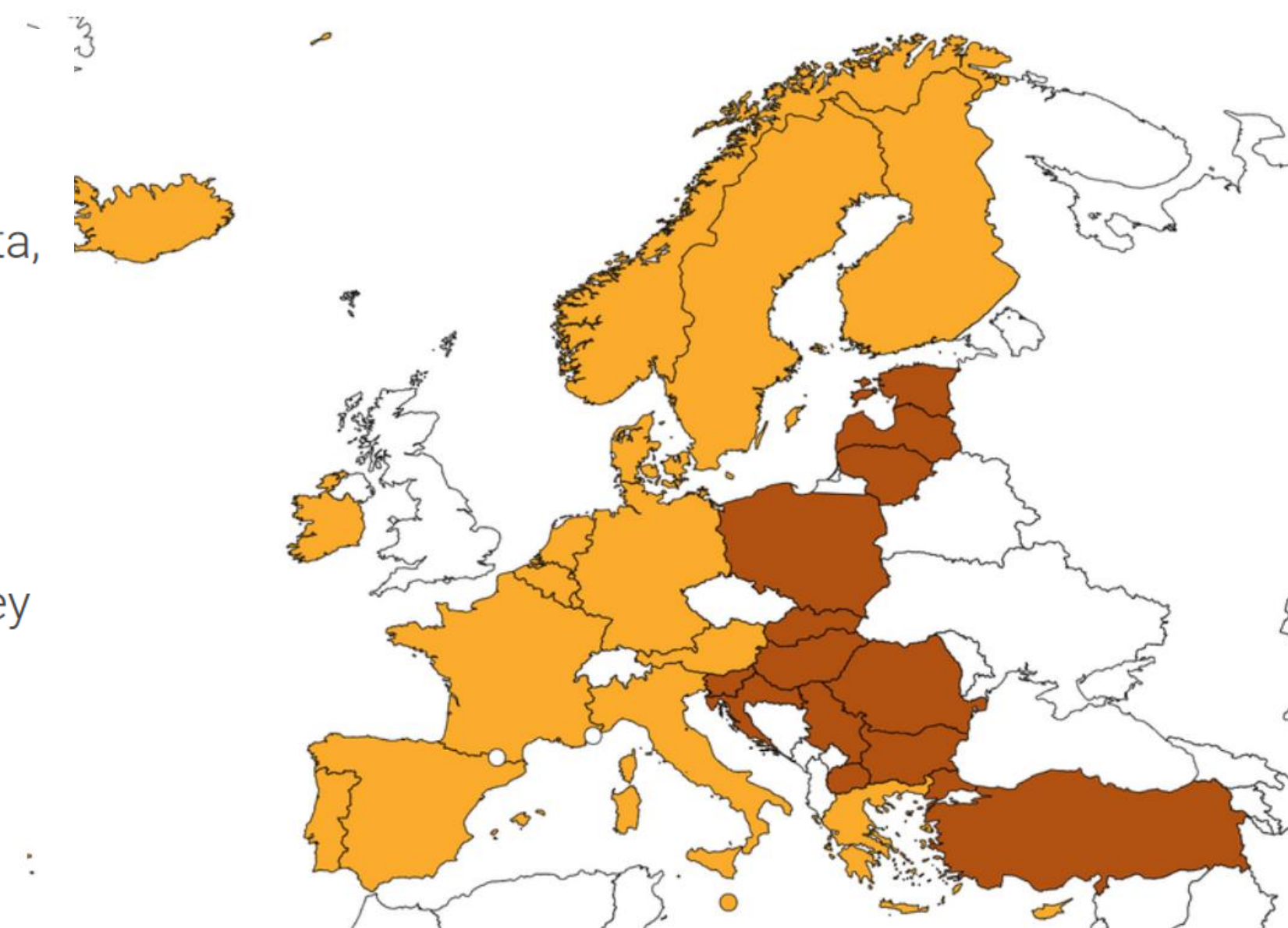

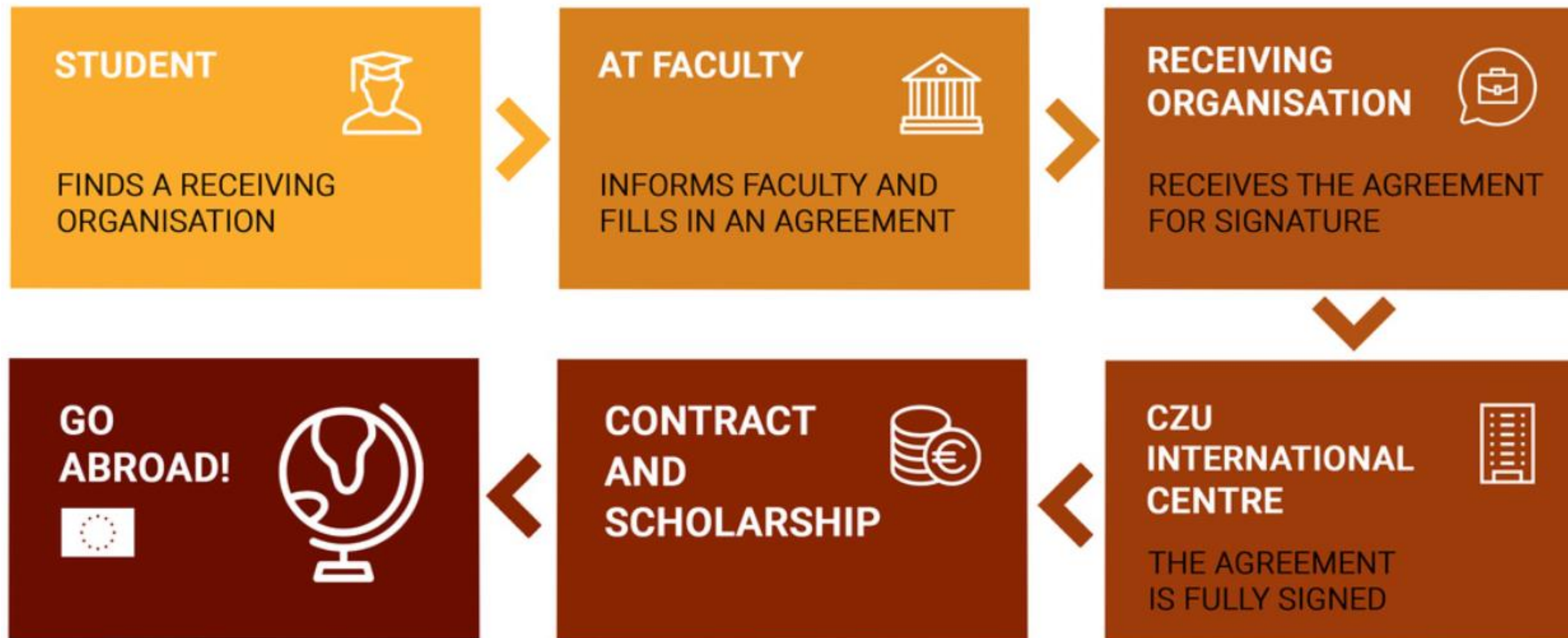

How to apply?



Selection procedure

Apply ideally 2 months before the start of the traineeship anytime during the year

- Required documents
 1. CV with contact details
 2. Motivation letter in English including: name of institution, country, preliminary term of traineeship and job description
 3. Language certificate (optional)

As a graduate you need to apply before graduation!

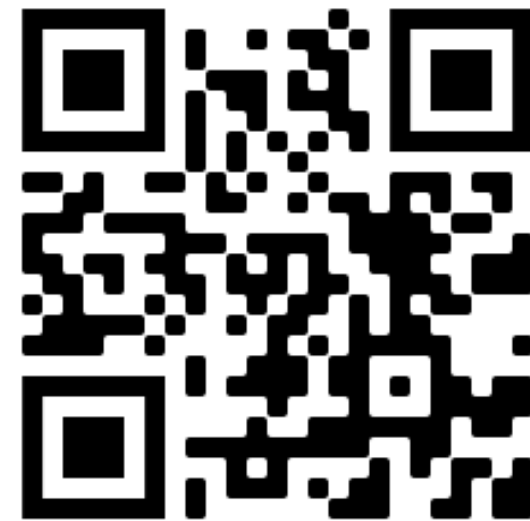

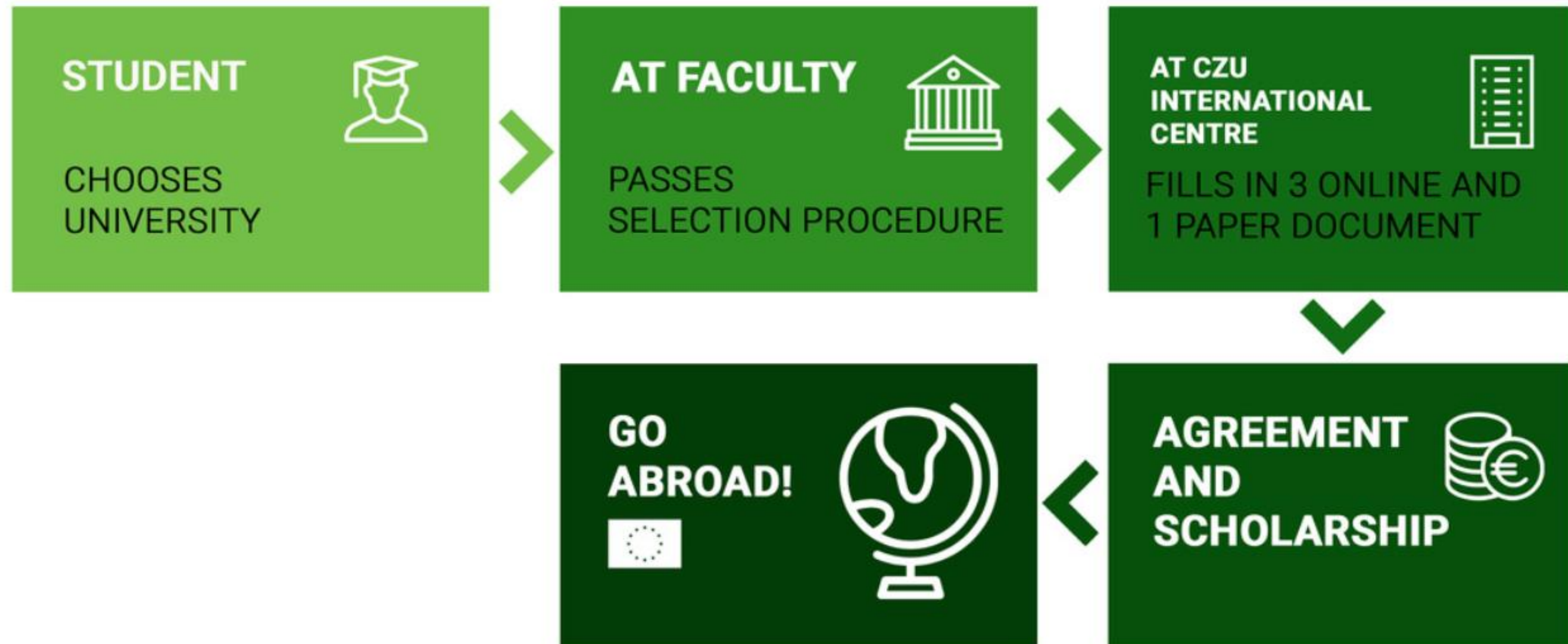

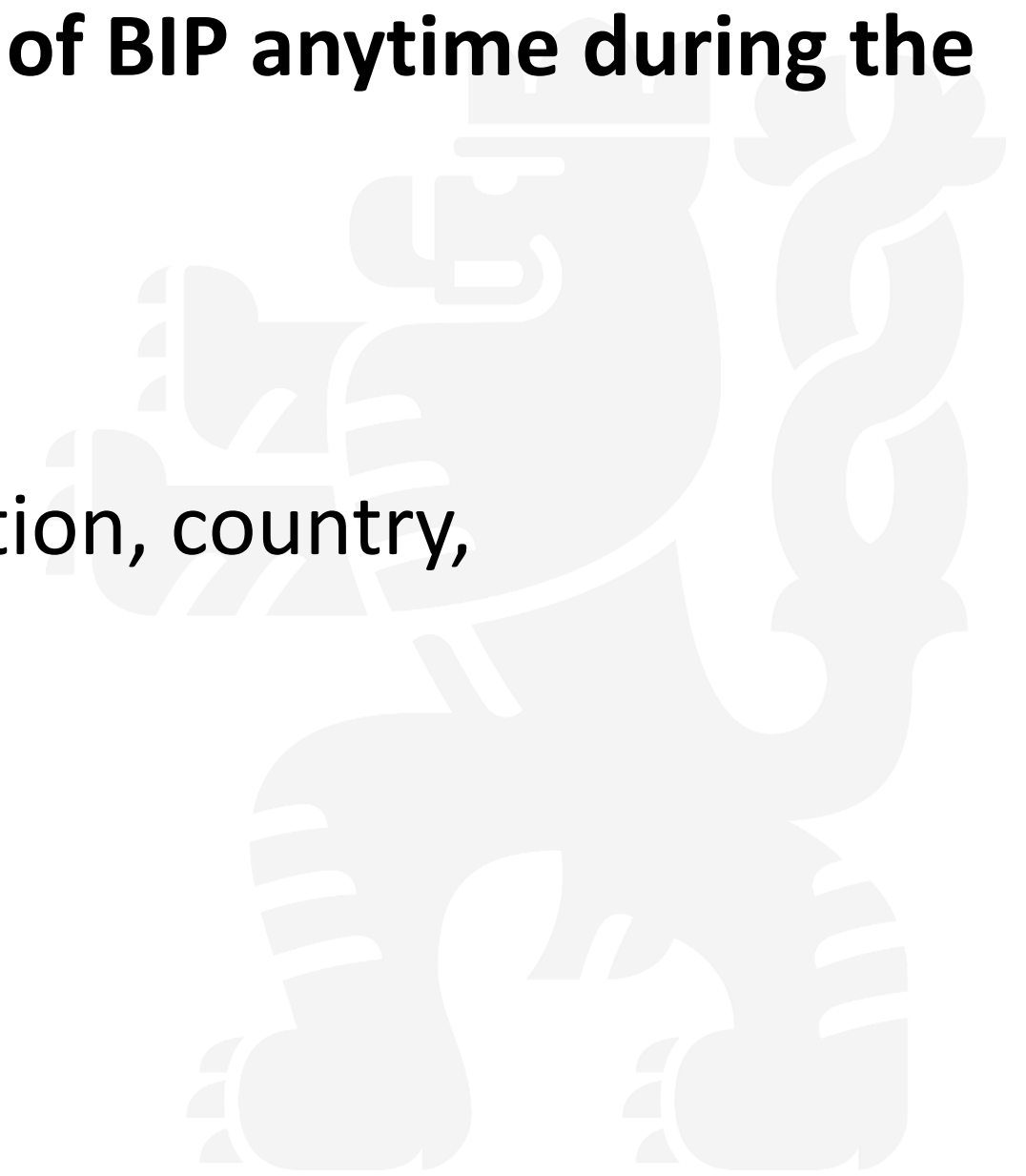


Selection procedure

3. Language certificate (optional)
