



Determination of the tuition fee amount for study in a foreign language at Faculty of Agrobiography, Food and Natural Resources in the academic year 2020/2021

Article 1

Introductory Provisions

- (1) This Decree of the Dean is valid for Faculty of Agrobiography, Food and Natural Resources (hereinafter the "faculty") of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter "CZU"), and it determines the tuition fee amount for study in a foreign language in the academic year 2020/2021.
- (2) This Decree is prepared in particular in accordance with Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education Institutions, as amended (hereinafter the "Act"), and in accordance with Article 25 of the Statute of the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague (hereinafter the "Statute").

Article 2

Determination of the tuition fee amount for study in a foreign language

- (1) The fee amount for study in a programme of study/field in a foreign language pursuant to Section 58, paragraph 4 of the Act (hereinafter the "fee for study in a foreign language") is as follows:

- (2) The decision on assessment of the fee for study in a foreign language pursuant to paragraph 1 of this Article shall be issued by the Dean or his authorized Vice-Dean of the faculty. The fee shall be due by 30th June 2020 for students starting the first year of study of bachelor's or master's study programme. Students of higher years of study are due to pay the fee before the date of registration for study in a higher year.
- (3) The Dean or his authorized Vice-Dean may decrease the fee amount to the level of the fee amount that was valid in the academic year in which the student registered for study. In accordance with Section 68, paragraph 3 of the Act, the issuing of a decision pursuant to this paragraph is the first act in the proceedings.
- (4) Other details regarding the proceedings on assessment of the fee for study in a foreign language, as well as payment of the fee, shall be determined by legal regulations, Article 25 of the CZU Statute, and

by an Internal Regulation of CZU for determining the fee associated with study and the amount of the payments for administrative acts and services issued by the Rector.

Article 3
Closing Provisions

- (1) This Decree was discussed by the CZU Rector's Advisory Board on 3rd February 2020.
- (2) This Decree was discussed and approved by the Academic Senate of the Faculty on 26th February 2020.
- (3) This Decree shall become valid and effective on the date it is published on the CZU website.
